What This Is

Kenya 2026 is not a short-term mission trip. It is the launch of a long-term, multi-sector Kingdom partnership — one designed to leave lasting spiritual, health, educational, and economic infrastructure in Kenya. The goal is not a visit. The goal is to build.

Five organizations — TPC Ministries, the Institute for Human Advancement (IHA), Uplift Communities, Rise Church Kenya, and the Kenyan Diasporic Alliance (KDA) — are joining forces across three cities and four service tracks to create something that outlasts the trip itself. Every initiative is designed with permanence in mind: telemedicine clinics that keep running, school partnerships that keep delivering, investment relationships that keep growing, and churches that keep discipling new believers long after the team returns home.

This is a Kingdom assignment with measurable, lasting outcomes — spiritual, physical, intellectual, and economic. We don't just visit. We build.

The Four Service Tracks

Every participant serves within one of four specialized tracks, each running simultaneously across the three cities. Together, they form a comprehensive Kingdom strategy addressing the whole person and the whole community.



Ministry & Spiritual Care

Pastors conferences, church revivals, open air crusades, street evangelism, feeding ministry, and prophetic ministry — operating in all three cities throughout the trip.



Health & Wellness

Kakamega medical camp (2–3 days), telemedicine infrastructure installation, local doctor training, and Mombasa health outreach. Led by Dr. Michele Y. Griffith, President of ISfTeH.



Education & Technology

AI and digital literacy training, school adoption partnerships, orphan sponsorship, equipment donations, and university partnerships. Led by IHA.




Business & Economic Empowerment

Full-day investment conferences in Nairobi (Apr 24) and Mombasa (May 1–4), featuring investor pitches, entrepreneur training, and mentorship. Led by Uplift Communities.

The Journey: 16 Days, Three Cities

The trip moves through three distinct phases — Nairobi, Kakamega, and Mombasa — with all four tracks running simultaneously throughout. A flexible 8–9 day option is also available for those who cannot commit to the full 16 days.



Flexible Option: Arrive April 26 (weekend), serve April 27–May 4, return May 4–5. This 8–9 day option covers the full Kakamega and Mombasa phases and is a fully welcome option for those who cannot miss extended time from work.

→ Who can join?

→ Do I have to come for all 16 days?

No. Many team members fly in the weekend of April 26, serve April 27–May 4, and return home May 4–5 (~8–9 days). This covers the full Kakamega and Mombasa phases and is a fully welcome option for those who can't miss extended time from work.

→ Is this tax-deductible?

Yes. TPC Ministries is a registered 501(c)(3). All gifts and sponsorships are fully tax-deductible.

→ Are scholarships available?
